Psalm 40:5-10

Saturday, March 23, 2019

Not long ago I was listening to my favorite radio station, KLove. They often feature their artists and have them tell about one of the songs they have written and performed. This day's feature was an artist by the name of Mandisa and her song "Good News". Mandisa explained that she had prayed for her brother's salvation for a very long time. One day her brother called her and asked her how he could be saved. Mandisa explained that after she finished speaking to her brother she got off of the phone and screamed to the world the "good news"! She said she wanted to share it with the world. In our scripture today David is telling us to share with the world all the great things God has provided. In verse 10 he sings "I have not concealed your steadfast love and your faithfulness from the great congregation." Today I want you to ask yourself, have I shared God's love or have I kept it to myself? This Lenten season we need to share the Good News. God gave His Son for us because He loves us and we need to proclaim that love to everyone we encounter.

So come on, tell me Your good news"**

My challenge to you in the next few weeks is to go out and shine your light in the world and tell those you meet the Good News of our Savior!

Place us in situations that we can shout or whisper the good news so that others will come to know and receive Your love. We ask this in the precious name of Jesus. Amen
